Our next Monthly Meeting will be at Alamanda Recreation Center, 1515 St. Charles Place in The Villages, on Sat., Apr. 14. Doors will open at 9:15 AM for socializing, with the program beginning at 10 AM. Beverages and light snacks will be provided and guests are welcome. After a brief business meeting and the election of officers for 2018-2019, these three presenters will discuss 'Mental Health Problems in the United States':

- 1. Dr. **Ruth Martin** will discuss her work as a practicing psychiatrist for 38 years in the Cleveland, Ohio area. Her talk will include a perspective of changes during that period for the field of psychiatry and mental health professionals. She will also address mental health courts, day treatment programs, mental health clinics and chemical dependency issues.
- 2. Attorney Angela Vickers will discuss the interaction of mental health with the legal system.
- 3. Practicing psychiatrist Dr. Ayesha Lall will speak on new medications and treatments for mental illness, and changes she envisions for psychiatry over the coming years.

There will be a Q&A session after the presentations, and the meeting will end at noon.
